

# Lowertown Alley Study

This study explored the feasibility for interconnecting a five block area of Lowertown. The concept focused on pedestrian activity with the existing alley network. Spaces were enhanced, new structures proposed, and activities suggested.

The study stressed the importance in preserving these alleys and their spirit while increasing the economic vitality of the area. The alley circulation interconnected the Farmers Market, Mears Park, and the St. Paul Union Depot.
